Kelly Callaway, instructional materials and educational technology division director, presented a schedule of Proclamation 2015 deadlines and an executive summary of the *Report of the Commissoner of Education Concerning Required Corrections of Factual Errors*.

MOTION AND VOTE: It was moved by Mrs. Melton-Malone, seconded by Ms. Hardy, and carried to recommend that the State Board of Education require that all publishers make corrections listed in the Report of the Commissoner of Education Concerning Required Corrections of Factual Errors. (Mrs. Miller and Mr. Mercer abstained.)

<u>MOTION</u>: It was moved by Mrs. Melton-Malone and seconded by Ms. Hardy to recommend that the State Board of Education require that all instructional materials meet established manufacturing standards and specifications.

<u>MOTION AND VOTE</u>: It was moved by Mr. Ratliff, seconded by Mr. Rowley, and carried unanimously to amend the motion to read as follows:

"Require that all instructional materials meet <u>applicable</u> established manufacturing standards and specifications."

<u>VOTE</u>: A vote was taken on the motion to recommend that the State Board of Education require that all instructional materials meet established manufacturing standards and specifications, as amended. The motion carried unanimously.

MOTION AND VOTE: It was moved by Mrs. Melton-Malone, seconded by Ms. Perez, and carried unanimously to recommend that the State Board of Education approve changes and corrections in response to written comments and public testimony.

<u>MOTION</u>: It was moved by Mrs. Melton-Malone and seconded by Mr. Ratliff to recommend that the State Board of Education place instructional materials submitted for adoption on the adopted list as indicated on the Report and Recommendations from the Commissioner of Education Regarding Instructional Materials Offered for Adoption under Proclamation 2015.

<u>MOTION AND VOTE</u>: It was moved by Mrs. Knight, seconded by Mr. Maynard, and carried unanimously to amend the motion to read as follows:

"Place <u>fine arts and mathematics</u> instructional materials submitted for adoption on the adopted list as indicated on the *Report and Recommendations from the Commissioner of Education Regarding Instructional Materials Offered for Adoption under Proclamation 2015.*"

<u>VOTE</u>: A vote was taken on the motion to recommend that the State Board of Education place instructional materials submitted for adoption on the adopted list as indicated on the Report and Recommendations from the Commissioner of Education Regarding Instructional Materials Offered for Adoption under Proclamation 2015, as amended. The motion carried with Dr. Dominguez voting No.

MOTION: It was moved by Mrs. Melton-Malone and seconded by Mr. Ratliff to recommend that the State Board of Education place social studies instructional materials submitted for adoption on the adopted list as indicated on the Report and Recommendations from the Commissioner of Education Regarding Instructional Materials Offered for Adoption under Proclamation 2015.

MOTION AND VOTE: It was moved by Mrs. Miller, seconded by Ms. Hardy, and carried to amend the motion to read as follows:

"Place social studies instructional materials submitted for adoption on the adopted list as indicated on the *Report and Recommendations from the Commissioner of Education Regarding Instructional Materials Offered for Adoption under Proclamation 2015*, excluding Cengage Learning."

<u>VOTE</u>: A vote was taken on the motion to place social studies instructional materials submitted for adoption on the adopted list as indicated on the Report and Recommendations from the Commissioner of Education Regarding Instructional Materials Offered for Adoption under Proclamation 2015, as amended.
