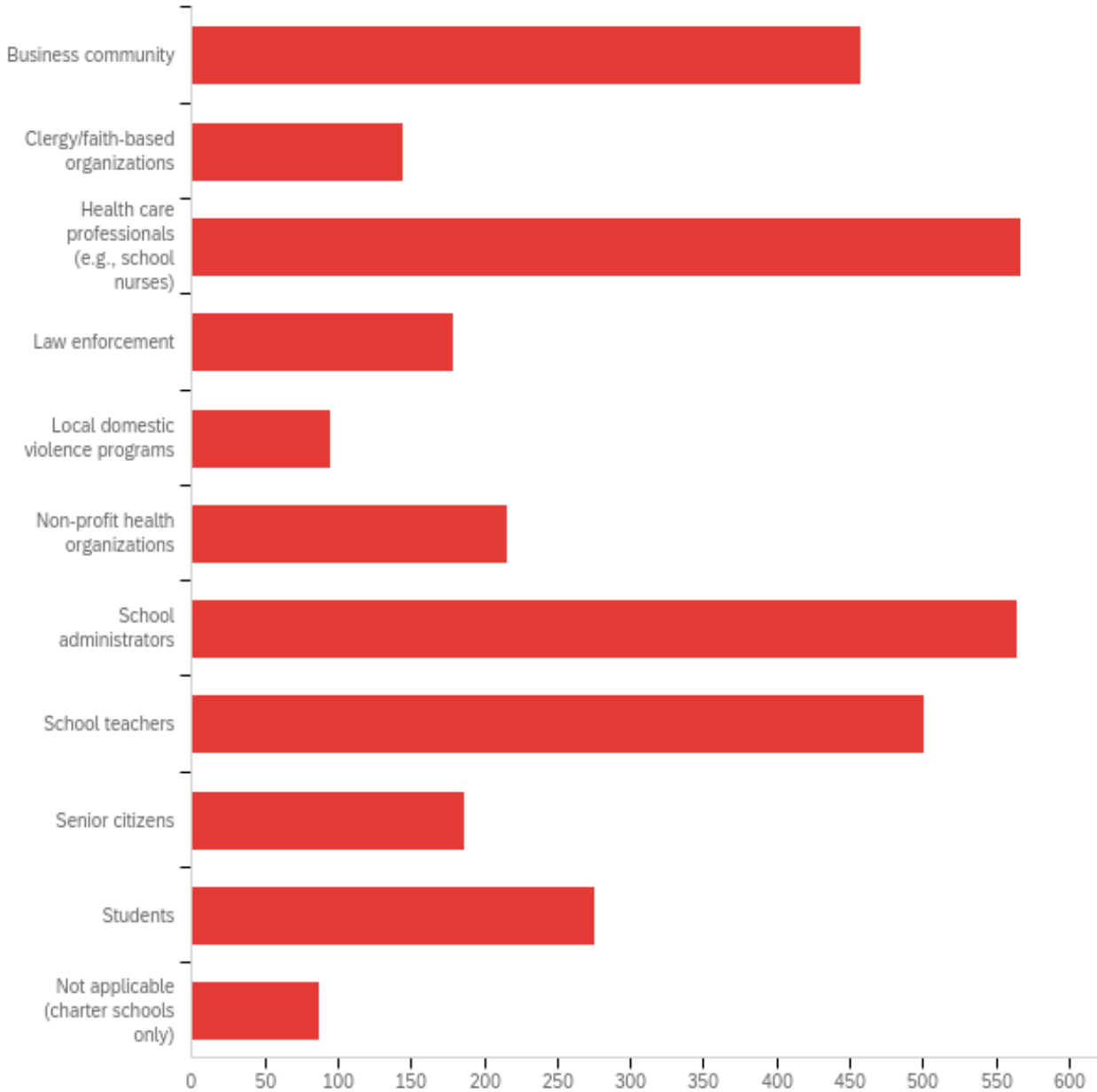

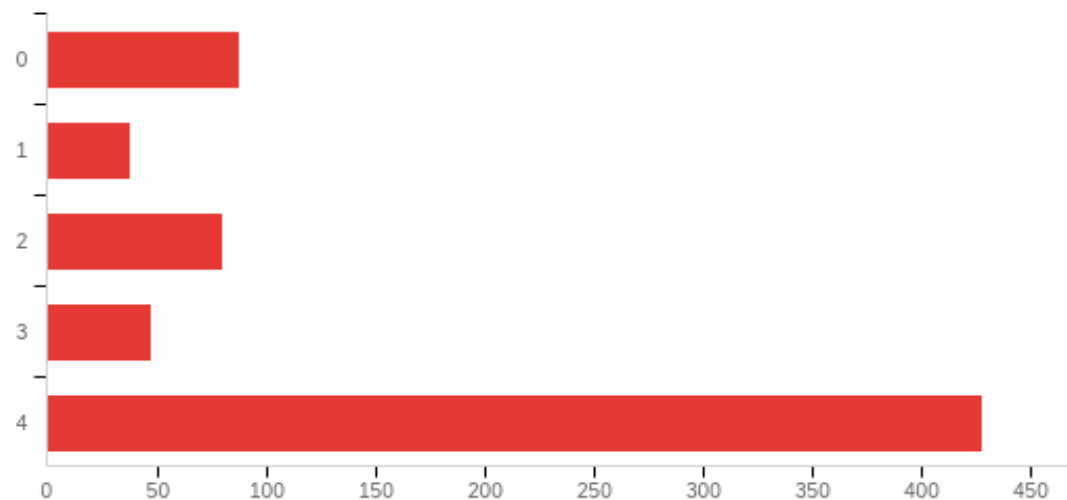
Q4: During the 2021-2022 academic year, were members of the following groups represented on your school health advisory council (SHAC)? (Mark all that apply.)

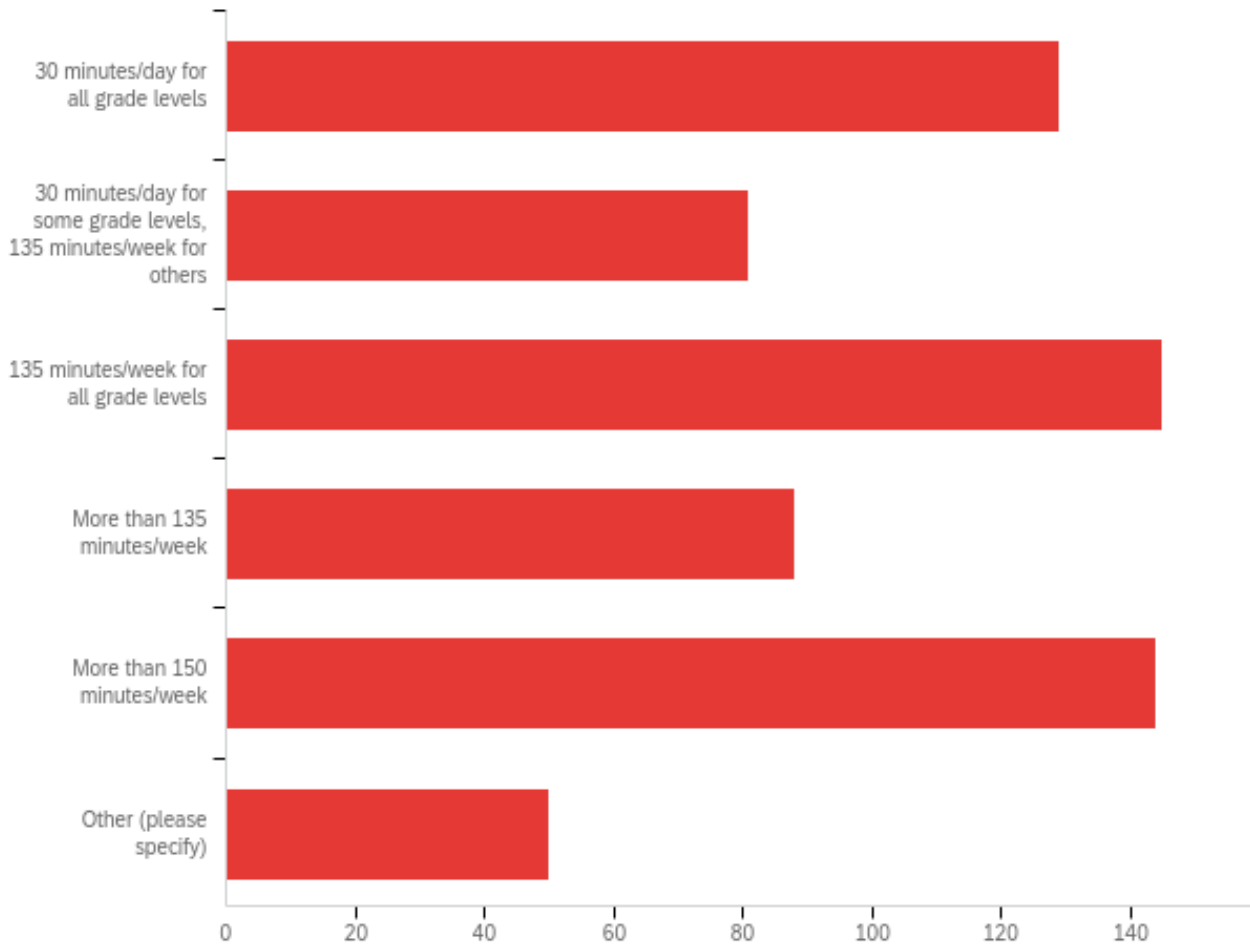

Q5: How many times did your SHAC meet during the 2021-2022 academic year?



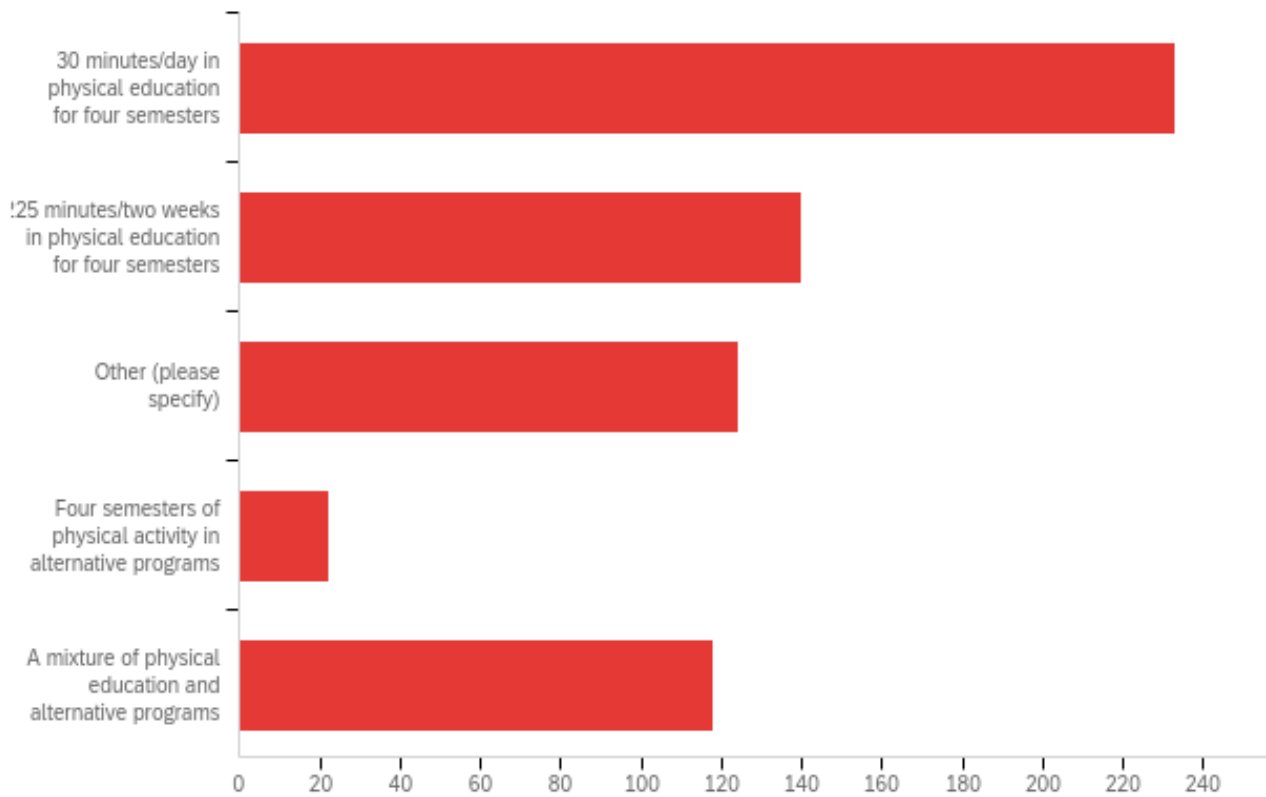

Q6: During the 2021-2022 academic year, what was your district/charter school's practice for meeting the elementary school physical activity requirement?



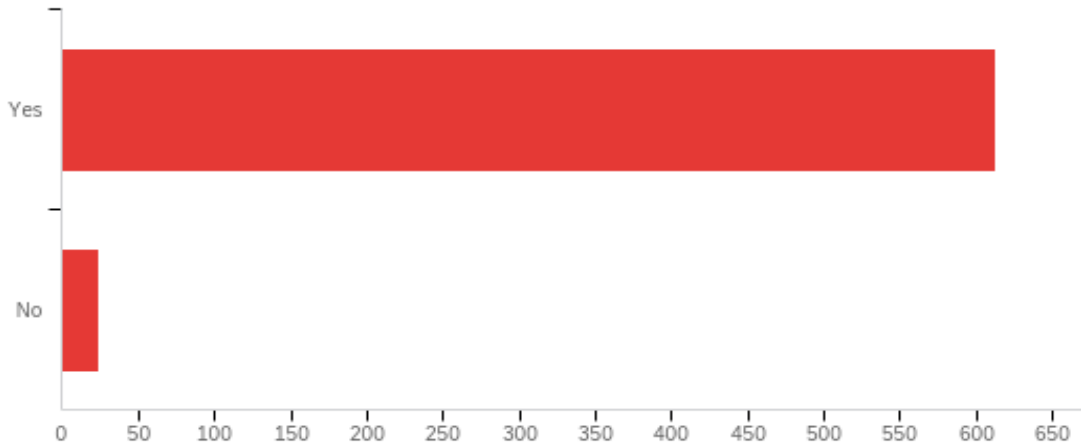

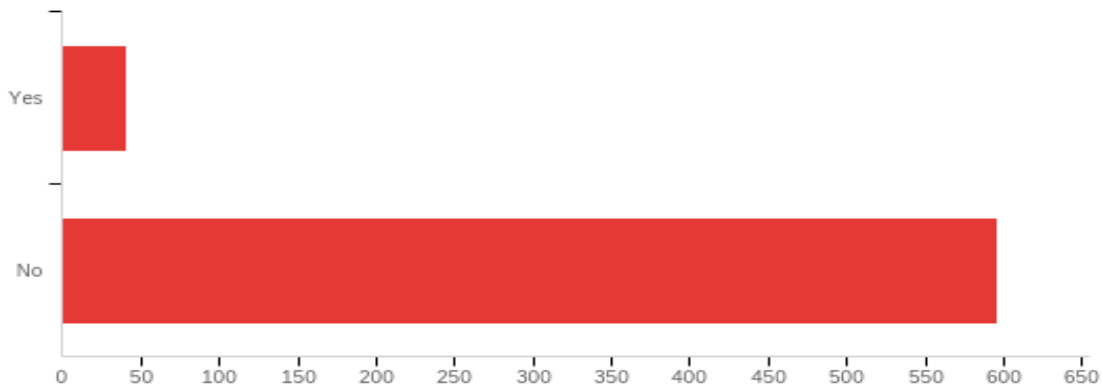

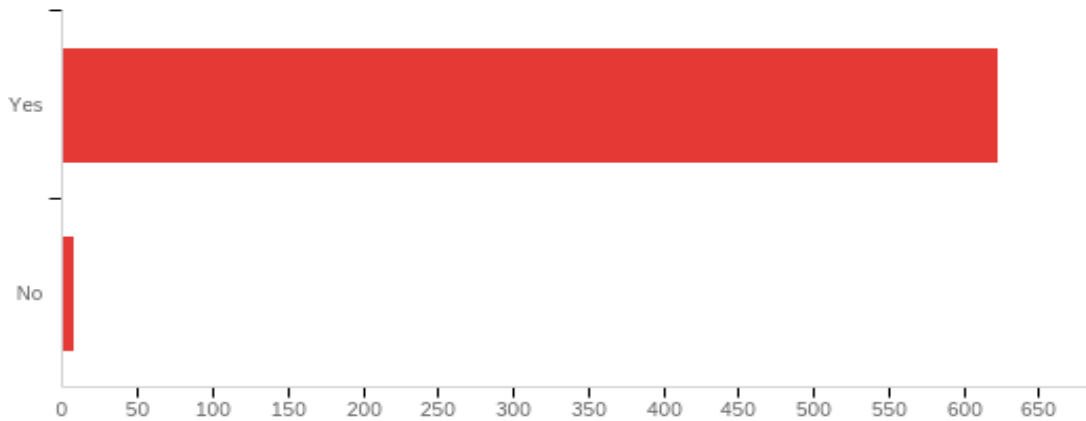

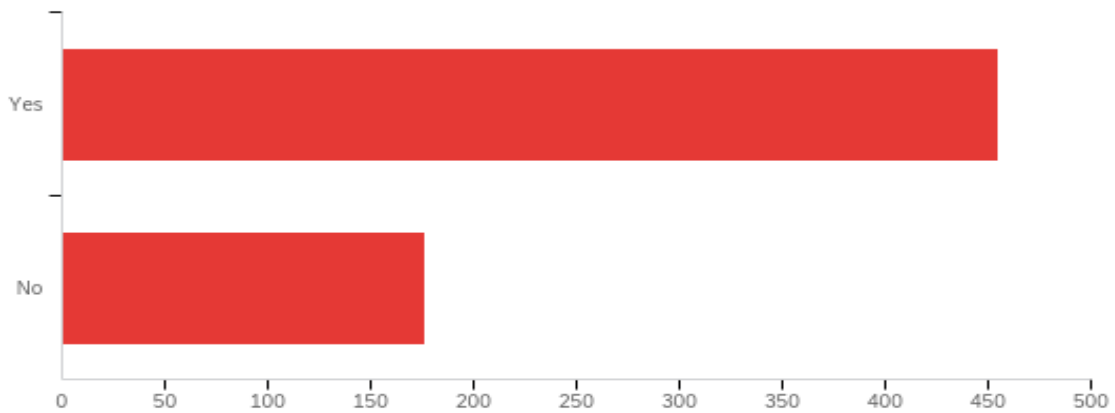

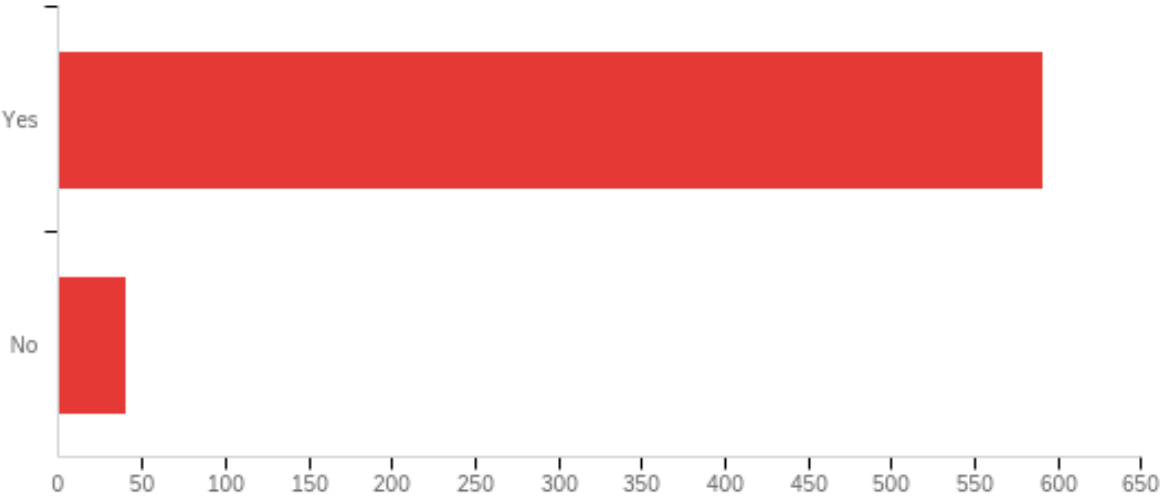

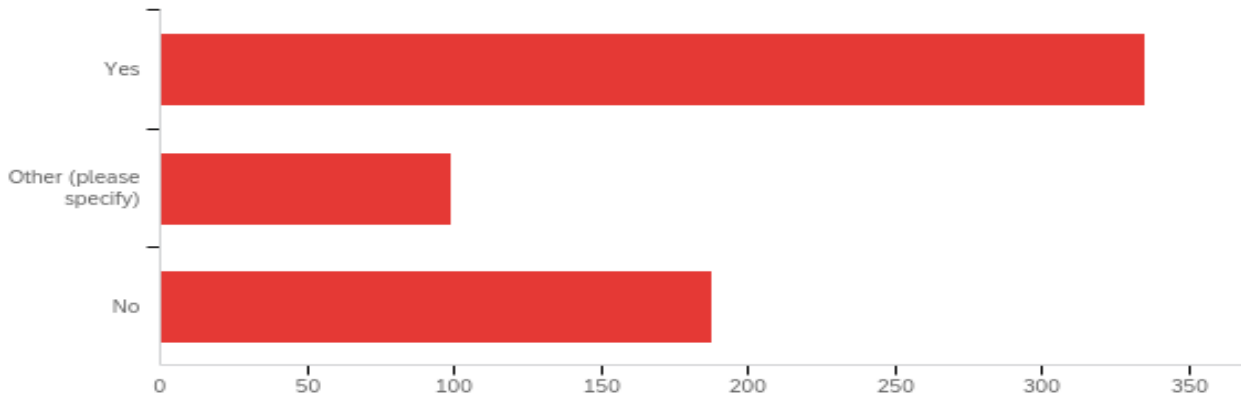

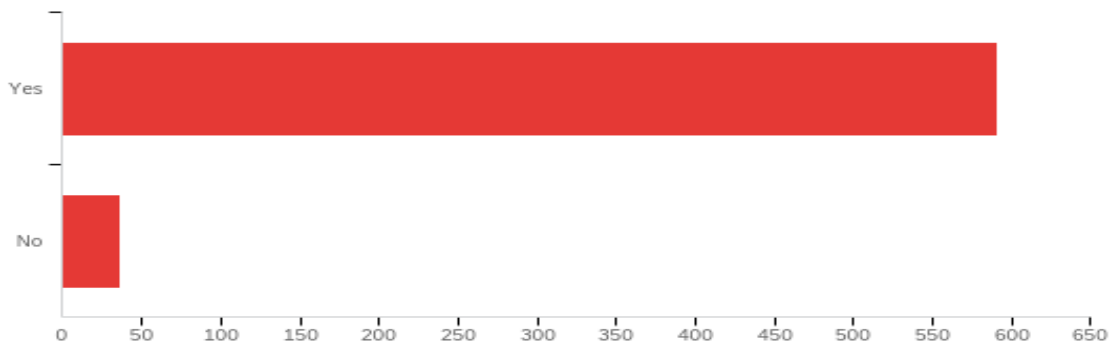

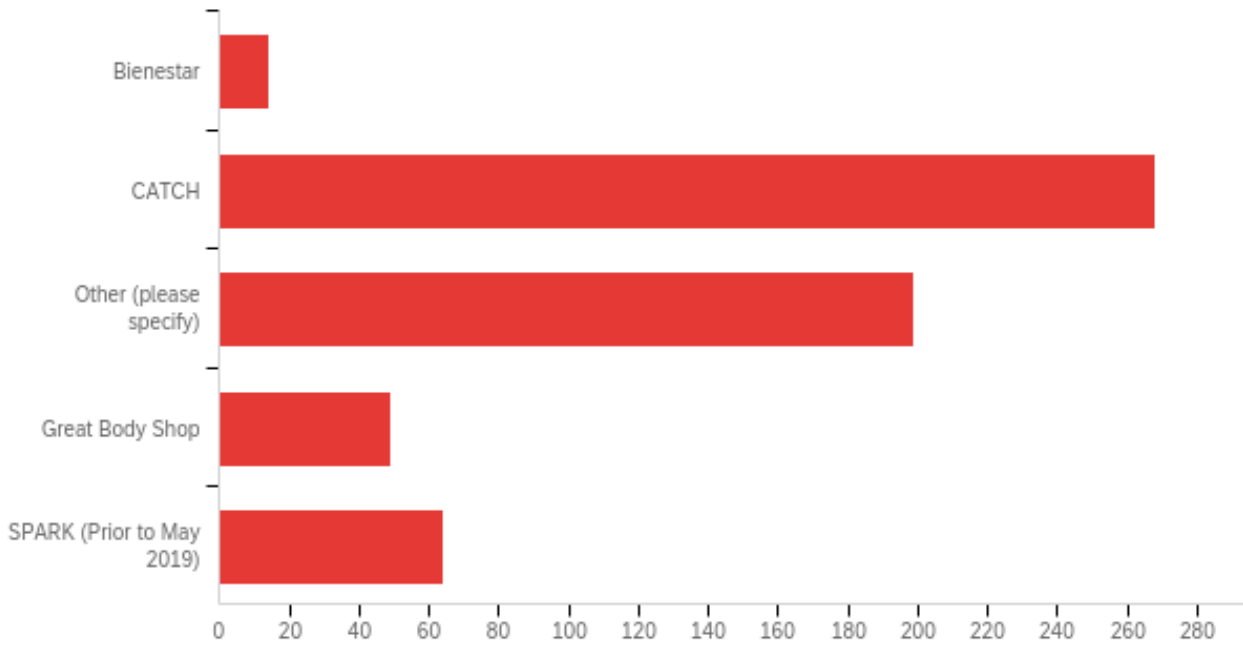

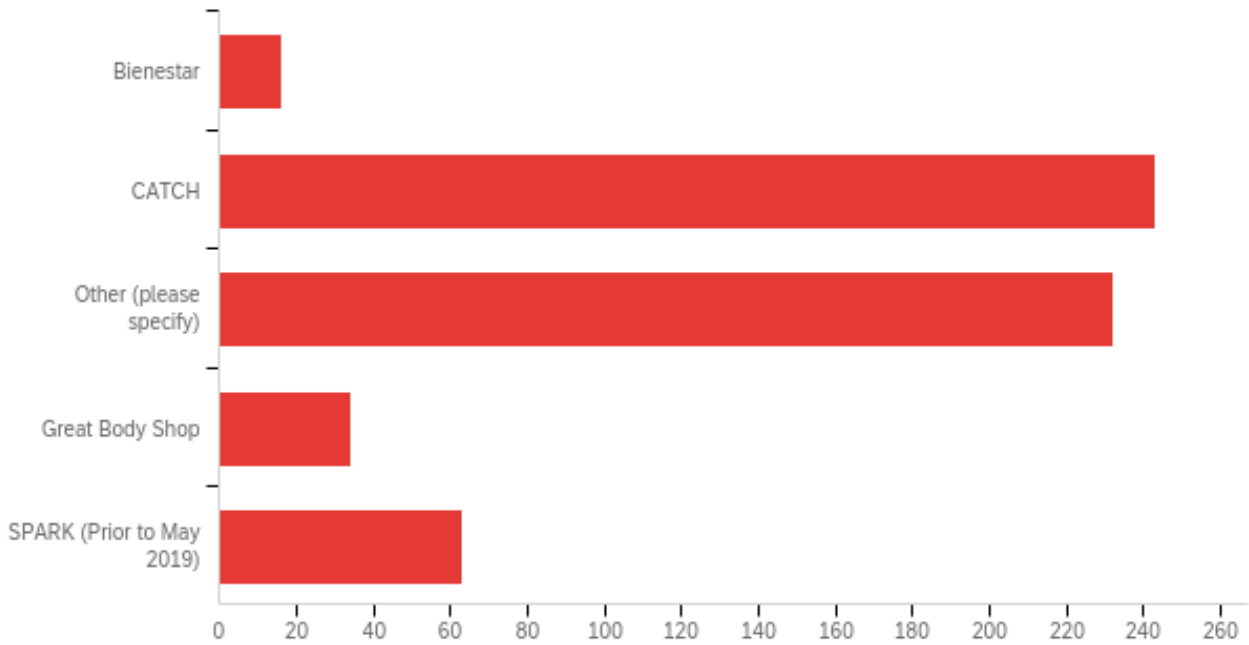


Q15: During the 2021-2022 academic year, which Coordinated School Health Program did your district/charter school implement in elementary schools?



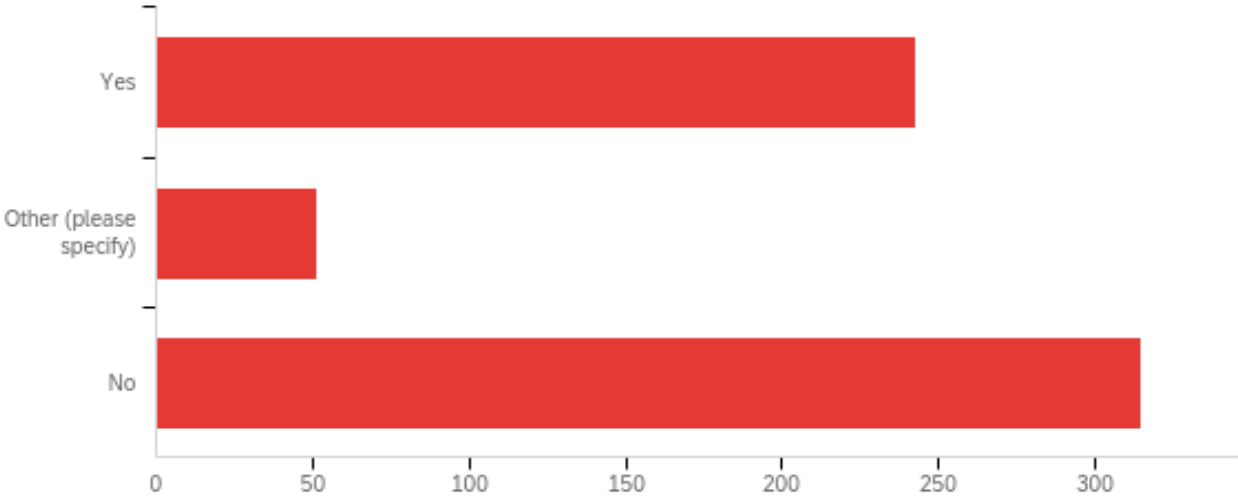

Q16: During the 2021-2022 academic year, which Coordinated School Health Program did your district/charter school implement in middle and/or junior high schools?



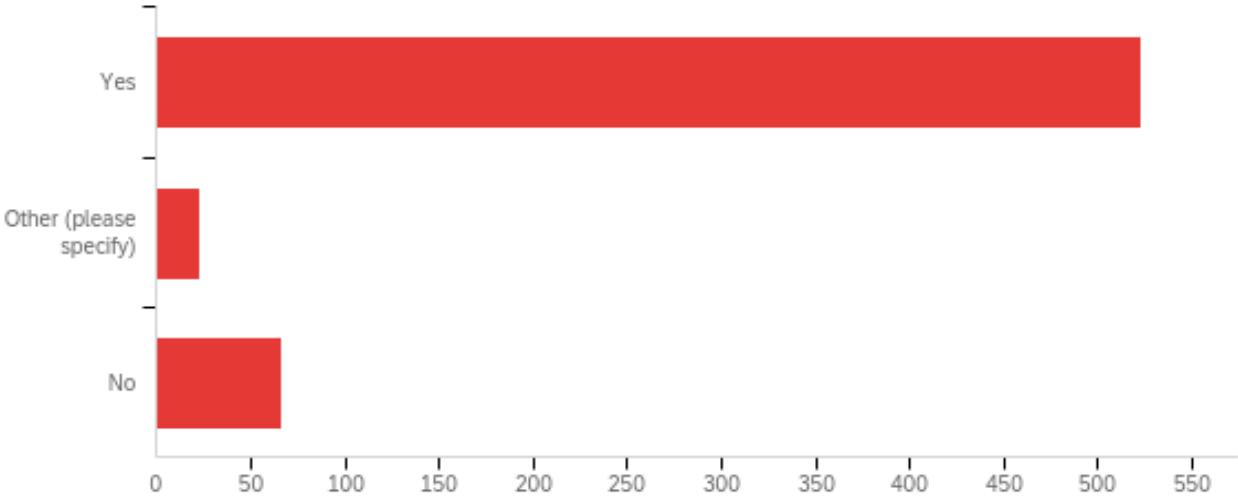

Q17: During the 2021-2022 academic year, did your district/charter school require health education as a graduation requirement for high school students in all graduation programs?



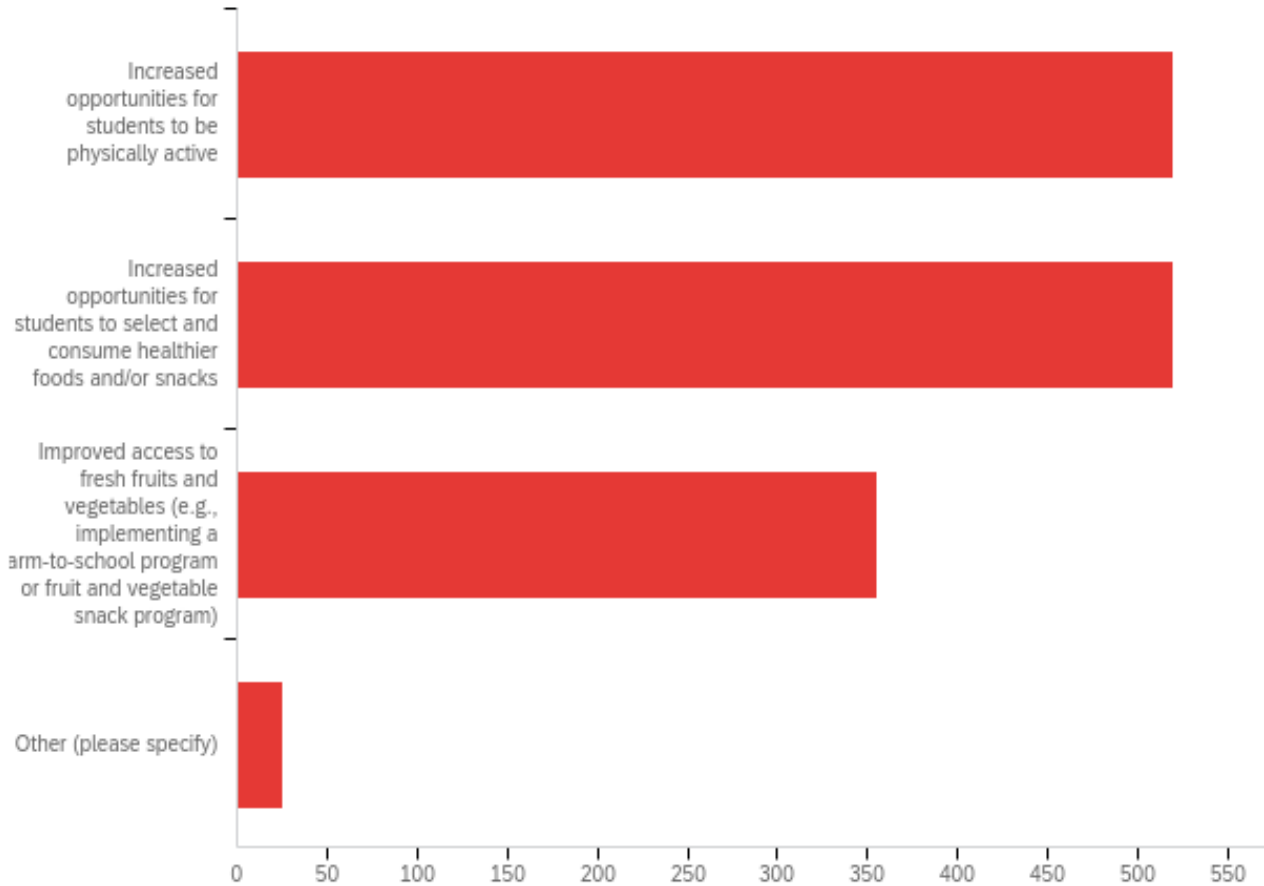

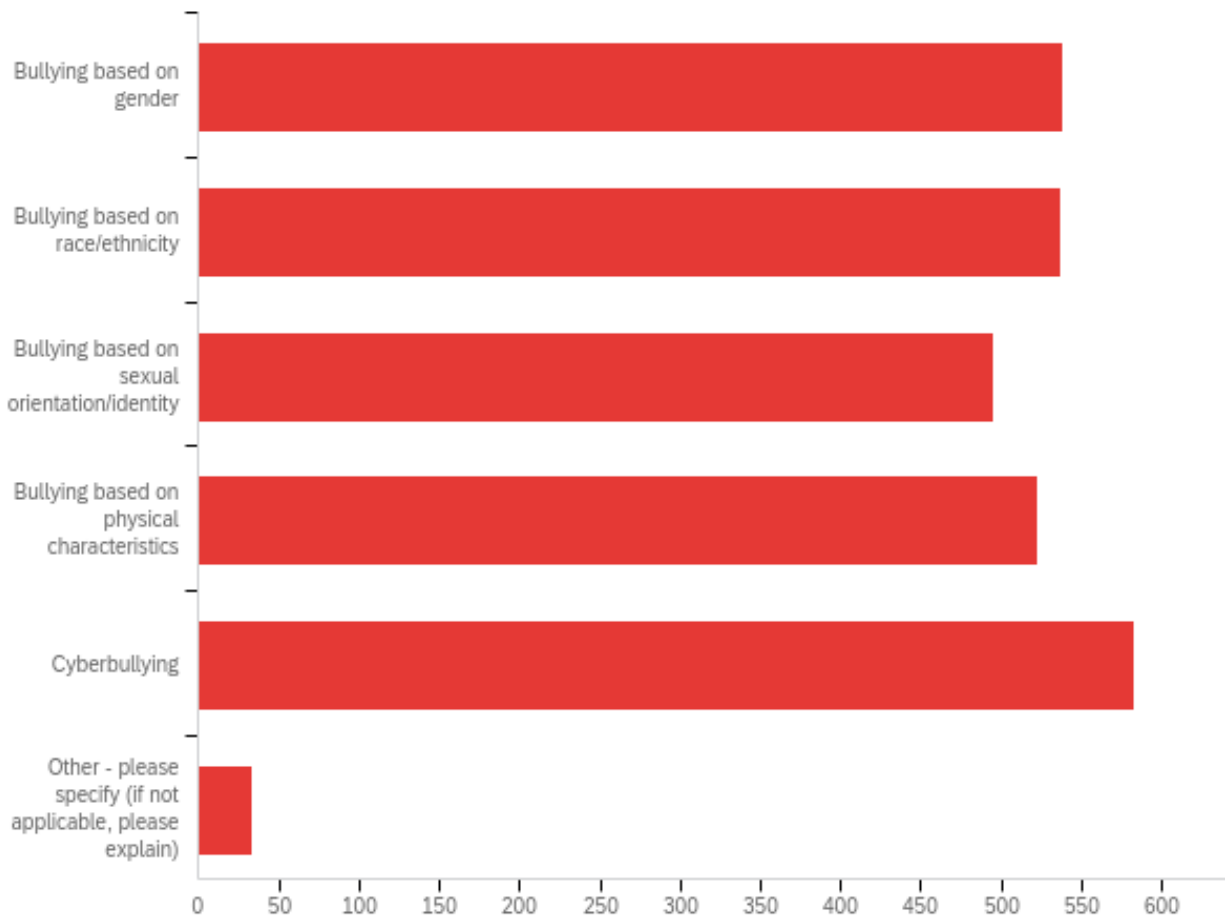
